



**Statement from Dr. Le Thanh Hai on new data from separate studies in Asia and Africa on the safety, efficacy, and potential lifesaving impact of rotavirus vaccines**

“The Asian clinical study findings contribute to the growing body of evidence demonstrating the safety, efficacy, and lifesaving impact of rotavirus vaccines,” said Dr. Le Thanh Hai, Vietnam National Hospital of Pediatrics, vice director and head of the emergency department. “Rotavirus vaccines should be added to a comprehensive approach to diarrheal disease control, including both prevention and treatment solutions to rapidly and significantly reduce child deaths.”
