Statement from George Armah on new data from separate studies in Mexico and Africa on the effectiveness of rotavirus vaccine

“While rotavirus is one of the most common and deadly diarrheal diseases, it is also one of the most preventable – with vaccination,” said George Armah, a veteran investigator and professor at the Noguchi Memorial Institute for Medical Research in Ghana. “New data demonstrating rotavirus vaccine efficacy in high-mortality settings provide policymakers with the critical information they need to make decisions about rotavirus vaccine introduction.”
