



Statement from Dr. Kathy Neuzil on new data from separate studies in Mexico and Africa on the effectiveness of rotavirus vaccine

“There is an urgent need to protect children in the developing world from rotavirus,” said Dr. Kathy Neuzil, PATH’s senior clinical adviser for vaccines and senior author. “The rotavirus vaccine studies published in the *New England Journal of Medicine* are a tremendous milestone in efforts to get vaccines against the most common cause of lethal diarrhea to the children in the developing world who need them the most. It is our hope that these data will catalyze action so that one day we can live in a world where no child dies from diarrhea.”
