


Driving transformative innovation to save lives

VACCINES

A healthy start for children



PATH accelerates the development of vaccines for diarrheal disease, influenza, Japanese encephalitis, malaria, meningitis, pneumococcal disease, polio, and other vaccine-preventable diseases, as well as innovative delivery strategies to ensure vaccines reach the most vulnerable.

DRUGS

Power over illness



We develop and introduce affordable drugs for diseases that disproportionately affect people in low-income countries, including drugs to treat or prevent diarrhea, HIV, malaria, and neglected tropical diseases.

DIAGNOSTICS

Detecting disease



PATH develops and introduces fast, accurate diagnostic technologies tailored to low-resource settings to detect and track diseases, including cervical cancer, diabetes, HIV, malaria, neglected tropical diseases, and tuberculosis.

DEVICES

Tools for better health



PATH works with the people we serve to develop, adapt, and introduce health technologies that improve maternal, reproductive, and newborn health; nutrition; and water and sanitation.

The foundation of good health




PATH collaborates with country partners using a suite of system and service innovations to strengthen health systems, encourage healthier behaviors, and introduce evidence-based solutions and strategies.


PATH's 2013 revenue was US\$315 million, with support from foundations, governments, institutions, corporations, and individuals.
